

**THE RITA LOWE \$1000 WSMC SCHOLARSHIP  
FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

This scholarship is endowed by the estate of Rita Lowe, a former Renton mathematics educator, WSMC Board member, and PSCTM president. The WSMC Board created this scholarship in the fall of 1995, to be awarded each year to members of WSMC for professional development. Currently, four scholarships of \$1000 each are awarded. Professional development could include, but not necessarily be limited to, personal mathematics education, training in pedagogy and teaching techniques, work on a creative curriculum project, training in technology, and/or cost of necessary or related materials. Although need could be a part of the proposal, it is not necessary, and would not necessarily be a factor in the awarding of the scholarship. Any current member of WSMC is eligible to apply.
